Strong creeping red fescue's sod forming, rhizomatous nature makes it suitable for sod production, while also giving it the ability to recover from damage or divots. JF-209 is recommended for home lawns, parks, corporate landscapes and golf course roughs or out-of-play areas. Adapted to sandy, infertile, and droughty soils, JF-209 is an excellent choice on areas where regular maintenance is not possible, such as embankments, deep roughs, and roadsides. Under unmown conditions, JF-209 will put up seedheads during the summer adding to the contours of your landscape. The dark genetic color of JF-209 makes it a good match in mixtures with Jacklin elite bluegrasses and ryegrasses.
