Applications

Sandrine is a versatile fine fescue able to grow in low nutrient soils from coastal to northern areas of the United States and Canada. Low input requirements often lead to applications on golf courses and home lawns either in fine fescue blends or as multispecies mixtures.

Sandrine also shows high performance under low inputs in a putting green application. In a low input putting green study performed at University of Minnesota comparing fine fescue species and colonial bentgrasses, Sandrine finished the final year of the trial with the highest average turf quality score. Sandrine offers resistance to Dollar Spot and Red Thread, likely allowing it to withstand low input environments year over year as a sustainable solution in applicable climates.
